August 1, 2007 - July 31, 2008

The dates in this calendar reflect the application of Bylaw 30.11 at the time of publication of this Manual but are subject to change per Constitution 5.2.3.1 or if certain dates change (e.g., National Letter of Intent signing dates) are altered.

A recruiting person day is defined as one coach engaged in an off-campus recruiting activity of a women's basketball prospect on one day; two coaches engaged in recruiting activities on the same day shall use two recruiting days.</p> | |
| (1) Those days from September 16, 2007, through April 22, 2008, not designated above for contact or evaluation purposes: | Quiet Period |
| (2) September 16 through October 6, 2007:* | Contact Period |
| *September 28-30, 2007: Evaluations permitted at nonscholastic women's basketball events. | |
| (3) November 12-15, 2007: | Dead Period |
| (4) December 24-26, 2007: | Dead Period |
| (5) March 1 through April 3, 2008: | Contact Period |
| (6) April 4-17, 2008, [except for (a) and (b) below]: | Dead Period |
| (a) One women's basketball event certified by the NCAA (Bylaw 30.18) held in conjunction with, and conducted in the host city of the NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Championship: | Evaluation Period |
| (b) April 11-13, 2008: | Quiet Period |

| (c) April 23 through July 5, 2008: | Quiet Period |
| (d) July 6-15, 2008: | Evaluation Period |
| (e) July 16-21, 2008, [except for (1) below]: | Dead Period |

- (1) It is permissible for an institution to have contact with a prospect who is enrolled in the institution's summer term (i.e., summer session or summer bridge program) and has signed a National Letter of Intent or other written commitment to attend the institution.

(f) July 22-31, 2008:

Exceptions

1. Evaluations are permitted during the National Junior College Athletic Association championship competition.
2. Evaluations are permissible in the following states only during the time periods listed, provided evaluations outside of the July period are counted toward the 100 recruiting-person days set forth above:

Hawaii:

March 1-May 31 and July 8-31

All states (except Hawaii) that play the high school basketball season in the spring:

April 8-28 and July 8-31
